






5. Where is the story happening?

1. Grandmother has a premonition that something bad is going to happen. When you read the story, did you feel like the boys should have listened to their grandmother's warning? Why or why not?






2. What do you think, when you hear that the boys let down an anchor 100 feet, and it didn't hit anything?




Let's Predict!

Let's Answer Questions! Who What When Why How Where What part of the story did you have the strongest emotions for?




